The University of St Andrews celebrates the long and fascinating history of cinema in St Andrews by recreating five classic screenings from the last century.

CHANGE OF VENUE:

The season will now bring film to different venues across town!



Tuesday 5 February: *Sherlock Jr* (1924), 7:00 pm, Hope Park & Martyrs Church

Buster Keaton comedy with *live piano accompaniment* by Jane Gardner, and 20 minutes of early footage of St Andrews from the Scottish Screen Archive.

Tuesday 19 February: *The Blue Lamp* (1950), 7:00 pm, St Leonards School

Ealing police drama, co-written by lifelong resident of St Andrews, Jan Read, with rare footage filmed by Jan Read at St Leonards School in 1937.

Tuesday 12 March: *The Misfits* (1961), 7:00 pm, venue to be confirmed

Recreating a St Andrews Film Society screening from 1965, the film will be introduced by Dr Elisabetta Girelli, a leading expert on Montgomery Clift.

Tuesday 2 April: *The Brothers* (1947), 7:00 pm, venue to be confirmed

Filmed only months before his death in St Andrews, Will Fyffe stars in this historical melodrama set in the Hebrides.

Tuesday 23 April: *The Birds* (1963), 7:00 pm, venue to be confirmed

In 1963 to celebrate the golden jubilee of St Andrews's first purpose-built cinema, the Cinema House screened Alfred Hitchcock's *The Birds*, alongside historical footage of the town. 50 years on, the Byre Theatre will recreate this screening.

FREE AND OPEN TO ALL

Cinema St Andrews examines the history of cinema within St Andrews from the medium's origins to the present day. It also examines the history of cinema through St Andrews, using the town as a case study to explore cinematic developments over the past one hundred and twenty years.
